### **Coronavirus Local Authority Discretionary Grants Fund**

The Discretionary Grant Fund supports small and micro businesses that are not eligible for other grant schemes. Small and micro businesses with fixed property costs that are not eligible for the Small Business Grant Fund or the Retail, Hospitality and Leisure Grant Fund may be eligible for the Discretionary Grants Scheme.

### **Coronavirus Small Business Grant Fund**

The Small Business Grant Fund (SBGF) supports small and rural businesses in England with their business costs during coronavirus. Small businesses in England which pay little or no business rates are entitled to a one-off cash grant of £10,000 from their local council.

### **Gigabit Broadband Voucher Scheme**

Homes and businesses in rural areas of the UK may be eligible for funding towards the cost of installing gigabit-capable broadband when part of a group scheme.

### **Locality - Neighbourhood Planning**

Basic Grant Funding: All groups undertaking a neighbourhood plan are eligible to apply for up to £10,000 in basic grant.

Additional Grant Funding: Groups meeting the eligibility criteria are able to apply for additional grant of up to £8,000 (in addition to the basic grant). This will take the total amount of grant available to you to £18,000.

Affordable Housing for Sale Grant Funding: If you are wishing to bring forward affordable housing for sale you may be eligible for further grant funding of up to £10,000 to help develop these ideas.

## **UK Theatres Grants Schemes**

The UK Theatres Small Grants Scheme is a capital fund that awards up to £5,000 to theatres across the UK run by charities and not-for-profit groups that can clearly demonstrate the value capital improvements to their theatres would make to their work in local communities. In response to the coronavirus crisis, the scheme will now be able to support theatres to cover the additional costs of reopening after several months' closure, including making adaptations for increased hygiene and social distancing measures.
